Position Overview

Judaism Your Way is seeking two reliable, physically capable team members to support the setup, execution, and breakdown of its large annual outdoor and indoor High Holiday services. This role is essential to ensuring a smooth and welcoming experience for attendees by handling the many behind-the-scenes logistics that keep services running on time.

You'll work closely with staff and volunteers to transform spaces before services, maintain them during transitions, and fully reset or pack down at the end of each day.

Key Responsibilities

- Load and unload vehicles with event supplies, including boxes, signage, water coolers, and other materials
- Drive supplies between locations as needed
- Transport and organize materials across event spaces
- Set up and break down seating (chairs), canopies, and basic staging elements
- Arrange and restock items such as prayer books, cups, and water stations
- Monitor and refill water coolers throughout services
- Collect and remove trash; maintain cleanliness of event areas
- Assist with resetting spaces between consecutive services (quick turnovers required)

- Pack, organize, and prepare materials for transport at the end of each day
- Support miscellaneous physical and logistical tasks as directed by staff

Work Environment

- Fast-paced, team-oriented environment with multiple service transitions in a single day
- Primarily outdoor work (weather-dependent), with some indoor setup
- Significant time spent on your feet, walking, lifting, and carrying

Qualifications

- Must have a reliable personal vehicle and valid driver's license, and be comfortable transporting event materials
- Able to lift and carry 30–50 lbs repeatedly
- Comfortable with physical, hands-on work for extended periods
- Reliable, punctual, and responsive to direction
- Able to work efficiently under time constraints and shifting priorities
- Team player with a positive, can-do attitude

Preferred (but not required)

- Previous event setup, production, or facilities experience
- Experience driving and loading/unloading supplies for events

These services involve hundreds of attendees and tightly coordinated timing. Your work ensures that each space is safe, functional, and welcoming - from the first chair set in the morning to the final load-out at day's end.
